Day 1 Saturday, June 12 Boston (D)

Afternoon arrival in Boston
 Meet your Tour Manager who will be with you for your entire stay in Boston
 Narrated riding tour of Boston including sites along the Freedom Trail and tour of Boston's neighborhoods, including Cambridge and a stop at Harvard University
 Check-in to the hotel
 Dinner at a local restaurant




Day 2 Sunday, June 13 Boston (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel
 Depart for a self-guided tour of Bunker Hill Monument and the USS Constitution, "Old Ironsides"
 Lunch, on own
 Independent walking tour of the Freedom Trail to include Faneuil Hall, Quincy Market, Paul Revere's House, and the Old North Church
 Boston Tea Party Ships and Museum – Explore a full-scale replica of an 18th-century sailing vessel while learning about the famous event that forever changed the course of American history. The museum provides a multi-sensory experience that includes live actors and interactive exhibits
Performance or clinic as part of National Festival of the States*
 Dinner at a local restaurant
Attend a Boston Red Sox MLB game*
 Return to the hotel for overnight



Day 3 Monday, June 14 Boston (B,D)

Morning sightseeing includes a guided tour of Cambridge, stopping at Harvard University, then continuing to Lexington and Concord, battle sites of the Revolutionary War
 Lunch, on own
 Visit the north shore of Boston to the town of Salem, infamous as the site of the Salem Witch Trials of 1692
 Admission to the House of Seven Gables or the Salem Witch Dungeon
 Weather and time permitting, take a stroll along the Salem waterfront
 Lobster Dinner at a local restaurant in Gloucester, Massachusetts
 Return to Boston hotel


Day 4 Tuesday, June 15 Boston – New York City (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out
Board motorcoach and transfer to New York City (approx. 216 miles; 4 1/2 hours non-stop)
Lunch, on own
Afternoon arrival in New York City
Meet your MCI Tour Manager for an orientation tour of the city
Sightseeing and NYC orientation tour may include Midtown, 5th Avenue, Rockefeller Center, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Radio City Music Hall, NBC Studio store, Grand Central Terminal, United Nations Building, 42nd Street Deco architecture
Check-in to the (Manhattan) hotel
Evening dinner at a local restaurant
Continue sightseeing including the Lincoln Center, and the Cathedral of St. John the Divine
Evening sightseeing includes a trip to the top of the Empire State Building or Top of the Rock for a night view of the Big Apple
Check-in to the (New Jersey) hotel for overnight



Day 5 Wednesday, June 16 New York City (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel
Morning sightseeing includes a 1-hr narrated NYC Harbor Cruise
Continue sightseeing of Central Park, Strawberry Fields, Bethesda Fountain, Lincoln Center, and Time Warner Building
Lunch, on own
Private Clinic with Festival Clinician
Tour the Lower Manhattan sights of Battery Park, Wall Street, Trinity Church, the Federal Building (where George Washington was sworn in as the First President), Winter Garden, and 9/11 Memorial (pending availability and advance reservation, the Museum is an additional cost and requires a minimum two hours and has strong content), Chinatown, Little Italy, and Greenwich Village, as time allows
Evening dinner at a Times Square area restaurant
Attend a Broadway Play/Musical
Return to the hotel for overnight



Day 6 Thursday, June 17 New York City (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel
Tour the Upper Westside including the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, Harlem, Apollo Theatre, Grant's Tomb, and Columbia University
Lunch, on own

Day 7 Friday, June 18 New York City (B)

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out
